Demonstrating understanding of the legislation

Organisations need to ensure that people across their businesses understand the new EU Mandatory Disclosure Regime requirements and hallmarks, and are able to identify and disclose reportable transactions correctly.

Disclosable cross-border arrangements fall within a broadly defined set of hallmarks, leading to a wide variety of commercial transactions being within scope.

The transitional period started from 25 June 2018 and over the next couple of years, individual EU jurisdictions will introduce relevant legislation and penalties. Therefore, businesses need to monitor the implementation of the rules, assess their impact, and record all relevant transactions post 25 June 2018.
